- Dr. R. Curtis Morris, Jr, Professor Emeritus in the Division of Nephrology, passed away on July 9, 2021. Dr. Morris came to UCSF in 1961 as a third-year medicine resident, joined the faculty in 1964 and had a long and illustrious career. He served as director of the UCSF General Clinical Research Center (GCRC) from 1974-1998. For his numerous seminal research discoveries related acidosis, bone mineral metabolism and salt-sensitive hypertension, Dr. Morris was inducted into the American Society of Clinical Investigation (ASCI) and the Association of American Physicians (AAP). With his long-time collaborator Dr. Tony Sebastian, he was honored with the ASN Belding Scribner Scribner award (2002) and the UCSF Distinguished Clinical Research Lecture (2005).
