Announcements

- The FDA announced in April that it had chosen a UCSF-led effort to create an implantable artificial kidney as one of the first projects to undergo more timely and collaborative review under a new pilot regulatory approval program called Innovation Pathway 2.0. The project is led by Shuvo Roy, PhD, a bioengineer based at Mission Bay. Target date for clinical trials is 2017.
